1.	The certification body shall revoke (withdrawal) certification in cases when, for example; • Failure to resolve the issues that have resulted in the suspension in a time established by the certification body shall result in revoking (withdrawal) or reduction of the scope of the certification.	Certification Committee (CC), Evaluation Committee (EC)	Letter of revocation
2.	The certification body shall have enforceable arrangements with the certified client concerning conditions of withdrawal ensuring upon notice of withdrawal of certification that the client discontinuous its use of all advertising matter that contains any reference to a certified status.		
3.	The certification body shall reduce the client's scope of certification to exclude the parts not meeting the requirements, when the client has persistently or seriously failed to meet the certification requirements for those parts of the scope of certification. Any such reduction shall be in line with the requirements of the standard used for certification.	Certification Committee (CC) Evaluation Committee (EC)	
4.	Upon request by any party, the certification body shall correctly state the status of certification of a client's management system as being suspended, withdrawn or reduced.
